Terriers INBIZ: Azra on Unleashing Her Passion for Music

Azra is a woman of many interests, but music has been her constant companion and teacher since she was four years old, she said. When she moved from South Korea to the United States at age 9, she learned English by singing and listening to American music.

After graduating from Boston University and starting her own consulting company, CLÚ INC., Azra found that her four-year-old dream never went away — music has never left her side.

"I only knew half of the alphabet when I came to America," Azra said. When she started fifth grade, she looked to music to find friends by joining the drama club and forming a girl group.

"That helped me express myself, communicate and also kind of learn more about the culture and the language," she said.

Listening to classic '90s pop artists such as Britney Spears and the Backstreet Boys, while also holding her girl group's rehearsals in her parent's garage, Azra immersed herself in American culture through a musical lens.

When it came time to apply to college, she wanted to find a school with a notable hospitality administration program, which she said is "not related to music at all."

She graduated from Boston University's School of Hospitality Administration in 2010 with a degree in hospitality administration.

"I've always kind of been an entrepreneur at heart," Azra said. "I think interning at so many places during the summers really got me exposed to so many different types of businesses."

But, Azra did not confine her college experiences by her major. She performed at the George Sherman Union for student organizations and was a dancer in Fusion, BU's hip-hop dance troupe, she said.

"During college, you know, even though I was going to SHA, I was always trying to take different classes," she said. "So I took [some] public speaking classes in [the College of Communication]."

Dipping her toes into the waters of

corporate America, she interned on Wall Street, but also caught a glimpse of the entertainment industry by taking modeling opportunities and trying out a girl group.

"[The girl group] didn't work out at the time because [of a] management conflict, but at that time I was so excited because I was like, 'Wow, I finally get to go after my passion and try to do it professionally while going to school," Azra said.

In the middle of this auspicious period, a health diagnosis unexpectedly hindered Azra's professional drive.

"One day I woke up and I just couldn't see anything out of my right eye," Azra

said. "That was when I was diagnosed with glaucoma. It was a very rare case."

Azra said she was ushered into a "dark place" as a result of this diagnosis and its year and a half recovery period.

"I had to put all my passions aside," she said. "The eye condition basically limited me from doing all the physical activities I loved to do from dancing to singing—everything."

Temporarily holding off on immersing herself in the arts, Azra said her eye condition was what led her to explore business and pursue freelance consulting in her senior year. "But, they say once you have that flame inside of you [and] your passionate towards something, it's always going to be there, it's always going to poke you every single time," Azra said. "Music and singing is my ultimate — it's my passion since I was four."

From moving to America and learning English, to facing the setback of her eye condition, Azra has been catapulted on several unanticipated paths. But, with every adjustment, music has always stuck with her.

While she was recovering from her eye condition, Azra found that her passion finally revealed itself when a professional photographer approached her for an international fashion modeling competition. "I went out of my comfort zone and I was just myself," she said. "Then I ended up winning, and that kind of helped me with getting a boost of confidence. So, that kind of put me back into the industry."

Through CLU Records, Azra will be dropping her debut EP, "Freedom," which is set to release on March 3.

"I wanted to do it to kind of speak out and finally let that inner voice — Azra inside of me — out," she said. "All these years of me trying to come out and trying to sing and own myself as an artist — I haven't been able to do that fully because of all the life events. 

"Shine' is intended to be an inspirational song to empower people to be their very best selves and highlight that they have the choice of being who they want to be despite societal and social expectations."



We here at PopWrapped are super excited to give our readers the first listen to her second single "Gravity." Take a listen to the track below:



Thanks for your time! So, now that 2016 is over, what are some words you would use to describe the year for you?

Hey All Access! Thank you for having me. 2016...hmm...in short? 'A Shit Show comprised of the good, the lessons, and breaking free.

What have been some of the highlights for you and your music?

Working and completing my first EP, meeting and getting to work with some amazing people in the industry.

What are you most excited about for 2017?

I'm most excited about my music career, EP release and everything that will follow. I had a great year in 2016 connecting and creating art with some awesome people. This year, I can't wait to do the same including singing and performing my music.

Did you make any New Year's Resolutions?

Oh the resolutions... So every year since high school I have a New Year's Eve ritual before I go out where I sit down, open and read my resolution letter from last year which was sealed and signed in an envelope (sometimes kissed and/or signed by witnesses! (Laughter) Yes, this is the real deal). Then I write another letter and list resolutions for the upcoming year-effective 'tomorrow morning' Jan!! No kidding with serious matters like this! I also have friends that do it if they're getting ready with me or if they're in my presence the night of NYE. It's a fun activity where you get to see where you were last year compared to this year.

So to answer your question, Yes. I did make a New Year's Resolution. However, this year, I switched it up & made just one: Go with the flow.

Growing up, did you always want to be a musician? Can you recall your earliest musical memory?

Yes, I remember being at my first concert at 4 years old, where I was sitting in the front row watching a pop performer sing and dance. I loved her performance so much, it made a lasting impression on me. I remember at that moment wanting to be on the other side of the rope, instead, and performing for people one day.

How did you come up with your alias name?

Great question... I actually wanted to name my future first daughter AZRA since forever ago... then one day, as I was writing in the studio, I realized that it wasn't a daughter I wanted to name AZRA, but actually the little girl inside of me who I have been with all along. AZRA is me at my purest form, loving to sing, dance and express herself. She was always that voice of intuition in me through out my life and I finally chose to embrace and set her free.

Why did you decide to not go by your own name?

There really was no choice. Growin g up I've always had this feeling and visual of a little girl in my heart. Every time I went through a challenging time, did something that didn't feel completely aligned with who I am and what I wanted, or did something I absolutely loved and enjoyed, I always felt another part of me speaking out. That was AZRA. Especially when it came to pursuing my passion in singing and music, she aways kept me honest and expressed her discontent when I was going off path. AZRA is in a way a symbol, the truest compass to my greatest passion and purpose.

I'm curious to know if you think that moving from South Korea to California at age 9 has influenced your sound and ultimately, you as a musician?

It definitely influenced me by exposing me to a mixture of styles and perspectives. Growing up in S.Korea, I listened to mostly American ballads, rock and pop and some k-pop, but it wasn't until after I moved to California that I listened to k-pop more frequent, ironically. So from an artist perspective I most likely subconciously picked and chose different elements from these genres and created my own style. New styles and genres in music always come from the old. Furthermore, I listened, sang, danced and performed to more music when I moved to Cali

because that was how I learned English. I passed ESL within the first 6 months of 5th grade all thanks to music (Laughter) and of course my teachers.

In March, you will be releasing your debut EP, "Freedom." What does that feel like? How long did it take to put this collection together?

Exciting, nervous, and and finally freakin' liberating! It took about a year.

What was the inspiration behind these songs?

The inspiration behind these songs came from wanting to break free and pursuing my passions after feeling confined by societal expectations and my own vices.

The EP's first single, "Shine" is incredibly inspirational and motivating. Can you talk about how it came together for you?

I was inspired to write this song after the devastating Orlando shooting incident last year. I wanted the song to be an uplifting and empowering anthem for others to relate to during the good and the challenging times in their lives. I wanted people to feel proud of who they are, to shine, and to always choose light over darkness no matter the circumstance.

What has it been like starting your own label? Do you plan on having other artists on CLU Records?

Awesome. It ignites my "left and right brain" at the same time. In addition to my artist side, I've always had an entrepreneurial spirit so making a music label lets me do both.

How did you come up with the name for your label?

It was a product of incorporating my name and playing with words. CLU initially was a marketing/brand consulting company that I created in college but then evolved into an umbrella company which involves book publishing, consulting and now music subsidiaries.

Are you still modeling now? I am. Do you think that modeling has helped you become a better singer and musician?

Absolutely. First, my workout regimen and healthy lifestyle and eating habits for modeling are similar for my singing but singing is more rigorous.

Second, modeling really gave me confidence and taught me the importance of being authentic from inside out and this concept is a huge part of my music. I think by modeling, you really get to observe and experience two different worlds: the world that you see as the model, and the world that people see by watching you model. Music is similar in that it's all about perspectives: looking at what is on the outside and seeking deeper beauty and meaning within.

Who are some of your favorite musicians? What musicians would you love to work with in the future?

Whitney Houston, Sia, Britney Spears, Drake, Katy Perry, Pink, and Alicia Keys. Oh man, this is hard to answer. There are so many different types of artists I would love to work with in the future and it just depends on chemistry ultimately.

At the end of the day, what do you hope is the message of your music? The message behind my music is the same as my dogma: "Follow your passion. Create your own show. The world is your stage, for anything you can Imagine is possible."

What do you hope people take away from your songs?

Don't be afraid to be yourself, be proud, enjoy your life, have fun, and be bold.

Is there anything else that you would like to share with our readers about yourself or your music?

I hope my music can inspire, empower, and bring joy and fun times to people.

On her industry...

I decided to become a musician because I wanted to live my dream. I've fantasized about being a singer/performer since I was four years old and I needed to live that dream. I also always wanted to help people, and I knew I could do this through my music.

On her biggest doubts...

In terms of starting my new company I think having some doubts is normal as every business owner has to know that there is risk involved, but in general, it only made sense to me from a business perspective and also based on my previous experiences in business to start my own. I have consulted for other big companies, ran my own business in different areas, and now that I am finally pursuing my passion in music as an Artist, I definitely needed to put all of my skills and knowledge I've gained towards the music



business and industry as a whole. I knew that I definitely did not have all the answers and accepted that the road was going to be filled with ups and downs. Hopefully more ups :).

On taking the leap...

I took the traditional route, went to college, got a dope job to travel all over the country/world and consult for multiple companies, but in the end, I had no choice but to finally follow my heart and obey my soul to my passion in music. Azra's voice inside of me was too loud;)

On the advantages and disadvantages in her industry...

I think in the music industry, the disadvantage and advantage are the same: dealing with a lot of the unknowns. This makes it that much more interesting, challenging and fun.

On something she wants the #LFCommunity to know...

I actually almost lost my entire right eye sight when I was 19 years old while I was pursuing 3 internships in NYC and singing and dancing in a girl group. I got diagnosed with an eye condition called glaucoma which was very rare for young people to get. It was a traumatic experience of three years which made me into the person that I am now. During my surgery and treatment, I was advised (by doctors, researchers, surgeons) to stop anything that required strenuous exercise and strain on my body. Which to me felt like a death sentence because it meant that I stop all of my passions in singing, performing and hiphop dancing...I did in fact

stop these temporarily and it took me to a "contained" dark place. However this experience enlightened me to see another perspective in life and to realize what is truly important to me and what my mission should be in life. This experience made me delay pursuing my passion in singing and made me go after safety and stability. But look, I eventually went all the way around and came back to my original dream.

The point of me sharing this story is to let everyone know that if you have a dream and passion, no matter the size, if it's there, don't ignore it. Explore it. Because even after my eye incident, and multiple other life events that taught me so much, however still threw me off, I still landed back here... to my 4-year-old childhood dream.

On something she's learned about herself throughout this process...

Trusting my intuition. Consistency is key and sometimes you need to create your own barometer. Everyone will to want to give you all types of opinions, but at the end of the day, you need to have your own measurement of your life and career.

On how she keeps her job interesting...

Being an artist and a business owner keeps my job extremely fresh everyday... I am constantly thinking, learning and looking for areas of improvement...questioning myself is very important.

On career advice for the #LFCommunity...

I got so much more to learn every single day... but if I were to share some of my learnings to the readers, I'd say:

What you give your energy and time to is what will manifest, so spend your energy and time wisely.

Go against the grain if you must for your dream. Embrace the hard times, seek answers in the midst of chaos. Turn yourself away from those who tell you that you can't and surround yourself with people who believe in you no matter how BIG, SMALL, RIDICULOUS your dream may be perceived. Lastly, be the biggest gambler of your life and bet everything on yourself;).

let it phase her. She formed a music group with other girls to learn English. She got involved in drama at school. And over time, she became accustomed to her new surroundings.

Her debut EP is set to release March 3rd, with 5 tracks full of inspiration for life. "That's my passion. It doesn't always have to be positive." Azra says about using her songs to speak out on various subjects. Her single "Shine" was written in honor of the shooting in Orlando. "I want to empower people, to let them know no matter what you can still shine and be who you are." She will be shooting a music video for that in the very near future.

It's a rare thing in today's pop culture that an artist makes a conscience decision to create music that will inspire and uplift an audience. Pop singer **Azra** does just that with her new single



"Shine," her upcoming EP Freedom, and the overall message the South Korea born/California raised beauty has.

Before Azra decided to work solely on her music, she wrote a self-help book, The Cupcake Theory, and started her own entertainment company, CLU Inc, but all things eventually lead back to music.


Interview: Azra

-Hi Azra, welcome to VENTS! How have you been?

I've been great. Thanks for inviting me to VENTS!

-Can you talk to us more about your upcoming EP Freedom?

This EP is an artistic journey inspired from my own hardships in life from not being able to fully express myself, falling into societal pressures, facing love challenges, and almost losing my eye sight which ultimately made me open my eyes to



create my own world... Freedom basically shows a glimpse of who I am at the beginning of my journey in music.

-Did any event in particular inspire the songs on the EP? This EP was meant for me to break free. So every song on the EP was inspired by a personal event / realization of my own.

-What's the story behind the title?

Freedom... it's self explanatory. All of my art is meant to be interpretive for the listeners. Freedom to me meant freedom to express myself and who I am.

-How was the recording and writing process?

Haha, the recording and writing process was pretty awesome, filled with revelations, long conversations, and just connecting and raising self awareness. I've been told that writing sessions with me aren't like a traditional session, it's more like therapy. I initially come up with the song ideas myself on a piece of napkin or whatever's in front of me and then would walk in to the writing sessions with my co-writers. I think there's so much beauty and art in synergizing with other creatives and elevating the original idea into something even more meaningful and exciting as a team. The rest is history.

-Any plans to release any music videos? Yes, after the EP release!

-How did growing up in South Korea and your family upbringing influence your music? Korean children are exposed to music and the arts at a very early age. So growing up in Korea, I started singing, acting, dancing, playing the piano and violin and performing at the age of 3. My first exposure to pop music was when I was 6 my mom played Michael jackson, Beatles and the

Carpenters NON STOP in our living room and I remember dancing and singing along to the songs in front of the mirror LOL.

In regards to how my music was influenced by my upbringing, my family is actually very progressive. My family's generational motto is: "Do it, then It will Happen" and this was engrained in me since birth. Since then, I've always believed in going after what I want and trying my best whether I'm taking the conventional route or not, and I think you can see that influence in my music.

- -How does modeling influence your music and vice versa? Modeling really gave me confidence and taught me the importance of being authentic from inside out and this concept is a huge part of my music. I think by modeling, you really get to observe and experience two different worlds: the world that you, as the model, see and the world that people see by watching you model. Music is similar in that it's all about perspectives: looking at what is on the outside and seeking deeper beauty and meaning within.
- -What inspirational messages are you hoping to convey with this record? Be your authentic self even if you have to go against the norm, speak up, stick through and have the tenacity to overcome challenges, and ultimately do you and go after what you want.
- -What personal struggles did you get to explore on this material? Working on this EP had exposed lots of vulnerabilities that I have been dealing with since I was a child. I realized with every song and chorus I was unpeeling another layer of myself. I like to compare the evolution of our lives to an Onion. This is something my brother told me about...we spend a quarter of our lives packing on all kinds of layers to our core, and then we spend the rest of our lives trying to unpeel and rediscover our core being. This basically happened during the course of my EP creation in a super fast way.
